

SIMPLA KIDO CHOPPER 20" - TEST

Simpla Kido Chopper 20" came to our editorial office to check how it works in practice. It was unusual for us to have to find a child about 10 years old for this request and because the mudguard had pink inserts it had to be a girl (boys as we learned are already picky on this age ... :)

Before we present our observations of mudguard kits, we first quote the description from the manufacturer's website SIMPLA:

"In every child, there is a small sparkle of Easy Rider, their bicycle is something to be proud of in the yard and when looking at their bicycle dad sighs and compares it with his. Thanks to our new KIDO CHOPPER mudguards this comparison will now be in the favour of the young cyclist. Made in two-component technology, the mudguards feature a unique design from Route 66. The chopper mantle geometry adheres to the tyre providing optimal mudguard protection. The soft fin on the end of the mudguard assists the protective properties. The channel in addition gives to the mudguard a high rigidity so that it does not vibrate on uneven terrain and stabilize the mudguard. The front mudguard is mounted to the fork with an L-shaped steel plate. The rear for the SDS is mounted on the saddle post or the L-plate, without the possibility of mounting the screw on the bottom of the frame."



Our kit is fixed in the L-Blade system, the mudguard is slid on it, and the fit is tight so that even when the bicycle is moving, it does not move. The mudguard assembly can take 10 minutes to find the appropriate set of spanners and later put them in place. It is worth paying attention to the quality of the mudguards. Once removed from the package, the first impression is that we are dealing with high-quality plastic. The rear mudguard will protect us completely from splashed back, while the front standard will protect your face, but the shoes of our children can get wet.



When it comes to styling I do not have the slightest objections, the most important are made precisely and it is not at all a scary bicycle! It is not without reason that our Polish manufacturer is one of the key players in the European mudguard market. This is what our young tester said: "these mudguards ". I think this short statement from the mouth of the child very much says everything. If you are going to buy a mudguard, you might want to ask the child what colour he or she would like to get, since there are 25 different colour configurations to choose from.





The price of 39,99zł is higher than the competition, but at this price, we get a very solidly made product of high-quality plastic, which to destroy must be solidly tried (I tried to bend and did not break or deform) as only, as is well known, children can. Therefore, it is worth buying gold, rather than buy a few cheaper sets.
